Things you should know about this year's Calcutta...

1. The cost of playing is **\$40 per player**. Please pay Ed Jones the full amount prior to your team's first game.
2. This year's Calcutta has 14 teams. There will be 7 games on the first night, resulting in 7 winners. As there must be 8 winners after the first night, the "Wild Card" team (the losing team that earns the most points) will also be considered a winner.
3. This draw structure means that there will be a points system in place that will apply to all teams on Monday night, and again on Tuesday for the teams that lose (excluding the Wild Card). Due to the points system, all teams will be **required to play all 8 ends**. If a game finishes tied, you must play a full extra end (it does not need to be played toward the home end).

Points Structure

- **+10 points** for winning the game.
- **+ 0 points** for losing the game.
- **+ 1 point** for each end won.
- **+ 0.5 points** for each end blanked (awarded to both teams).
- **+ 0.1 points** for point differential for the winning team (to a maximum of 0.8).
- **-0.1 points** for point differential for the losing team (to a maximum of 0.8).

Note: No points are awarded for an extra end, except for the 10 points to the winning team and points for scoring differential.

4. Team matchups for Monday night will be drawn out of a hat at the Auction. The point totals will decide the matchups for Tuesday night and onward. Please see the enclosed draw for more details.
5. Due to the possibility of a tie with the points standings, there will need to be a shootout by all teams on Monday night, and all losing teams for Tuesday night. To keep the shootout from taking too much time, only one player will be asked to throw a rock (with sweeping). This player does not necessarily have to be the skip. Should this player miss the house, another player must attempt until a measurement can be made.
6. **New this year:** You are welcome to adjust your team's positions throughout the week. However, you must declare your lineup (including the vice-skip) prior to your first game. The teams, as they are listed in this package, show the positions that have been declared by each team's skip. A 'V' indicates that this player has been designated as the vice-skip. If there is no 'V', the broom-holder for skip stones is the third.
7. If one of your players is unable to play, please inform one of the Committee members and we will find you a suitable spare. Bringing your own spare is forbidden.

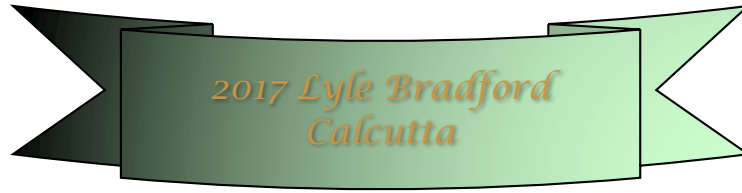
